Notice of Educational Collaboration between Humboldt State University and Seattle Community College District

In order to benefit both Humboldt State University (HSU) in Arcata, California and the Seattle Community College District (SCDD), made up of the Seattle Community College District (SCCD), consisting of North Seattle Community College, South Seattle Community College and Seattle Central Community College in Seattle, Washington, in the recruitment and retention of international students; and to assist international students in their educational planning in and the completion of a bachelor's degree;

HSU and SCCD commit to maintain and enhance relations between our organizations with regard to facilitating a smooth transition and guaranteed admission for all qualified SCCD students, who will have completed, at time of enrollment, 60 transferrable semester units to HSU with upper-division transfer (Junior) standing.*

HSU defines qualified SCCD students as those who have:

- Completed or are working toward a Seattle Community College Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree
- Achieved a minimum cumulative college-level GPA of 2.0 on transferrable coursework.
- Completed all CSU "Golden 4" classes with a grade of "C" or better
 - Composition (A1): ENGL 101 and ENGL 102
 - Oral Communication (A2): CMST 220
 - Critical Thinking (A3): PHIL 106 or PHIL 118
 - Math (B3): One of MATH 102, 116, 120, 141, 142, 148, 151, 152, 153, 220, 224, 238.
- Met HSU English proficiency requirements
- Demonstrated proof of financial ability
- Met posted deadlines for the requested term of admission

*The qualifications for guaranteed admission to HSU (listed above) reflect HSU admission requirements for the 2013-14 academic year. In the event that HSU admission requirements change, future SCCD applicants to HSU will also be guaranteed admission if they meet all HSU admission requirements for their admission term. Furthermore:


- SCCD will inform prospective students of this partnership
