



**Cooperative Academic Agreement
Between
Seattle Community College District
And
The Arizona Board of Regents
For and on Behalf of
Northern Arizona University**



In view of a common commitment to global education, to continue to promote understanding and goodwill, to strengthen cultural ties, and to broaden the experience and horizons of faculty and students, the Seattle Community College District and (hereinafter referred to as SCCD) and The Arizona Board of Regents for and on behalf of Northern Arizona University, (hereinafter referred to as NAU) agree to enter into a cooperative academic relationship for the purpose of facilitating an easier transfer of students from SCCD to NAU. The following are the terms of this direct transfer agreement (DTA):

1. Upon completion of the Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) degree at the Seattle Community Colleges, students will be accepted by Northern Arizona University at junior status with up to 64 semester transfer credits. Transferring students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or C. Courses numbered lower than 100-level are not included in this transfer agreement.
2. SCCD students are eligible to enroll in any program NAU to which transfer students are admitted.
3. International students who complete ENG 101 and ENG 102 with a grade of 2.0 or higher will have met the English proficiency requirements of Northern Arizona University, and will not need to submit separate proof of English proficiency at the time of application.
4. SCCD and NAU may choose to co-develop written materials outlining for SCCD students programs, policies and procedures relevant to this DTA. This DTA will be publicized in newsletters, course schedules and other promotional materials.


5. NAU reserves the right to make the final admission decision regarding all applications.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary. This agreement may be terminated by the SCCD or NAU with appropriate written notification. Each institution agrees to provide termination notice one year prior to intended change.

Neither party will discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, national origin, color, religion, sexual orientation, veterans/national guard/reserves status, disability or any other prohibited characteristic.


